## 2015 CUVÉE CONSTANTIN PINOT NOIR

*A lifted, perfumed nose boasting a myriad of aromas: raspberry, plum, wild strawberry, violets, and graphite. The medium bodied, yet lean palate is replete with persistent, bright red berry and bakers spice character balancing the firm acidity and refined tannins. Enjoy this wine now or with short term cellaring.*

## 75% FLANERIE VINEYARD

*Ribbon Ridge AVA*

*200-350' Elevation | Eastern Exposure*

*Marine Sedimentary Soils (Willakenzie Series)*

*Planted to Wadenswil, 667, 777 & Pommard Clones*

*The Flanerie Vineyard, planted in 2003 sits facing due east on the southern edge of the Ribbon Ridge AVA. The terrain is comprised of a thin layer of topsoil over a deep seam of marine sedimentary motherrock. These dry farmed vines produce intense wines with dark fruit and unique meaty/savory signature.*

## 25% X-NOVO VINEYARD

*Eola-Amity Hills AVA*

*550' Elevation | Eastern Exposure | Volcanic/Decomposed Basalt Soils*

*Planted to Mixed Pinot Noir Clones*

*This is a beautiful site planted with a mixed of clones collected by the owner, Craig Williams, throughout his years working in the California wine industry. This sun soaked vineyard faces east with an unobstructed view of the Cascade mountain range. The finished wines from these deep Jory soils yield a vivid wine that explodes with juicy red fruit.*
